Tokushimakita High School is one of the best academic high schools in Tokushima Prefecture. It is situated in the northern part of Tokushima city, which is the capital city of Tokushima Prefecture. It has 24 classes and 955 students. It was established in 1995. Tokushimakita High School seeks to provide a high level of secondary education to meet the needs of Tokushima Prefecture. It has two main courses, a general education course and an international English course. Tokushimakita High School is unique in that it is the only school in Tokushima which has an international English course. The general course has two subcourses; the science subcourse and the humanities subcourse. The international English course has also two subcourses; a science subcourse, a humanities subcourse. Education at Tokushimakita High School is enjoyable through a stable environment, efficient organizational structures, caring teachers, a curriculum which caters to all ability groups in a setting where discipline is firm but fair, and characterized by mutual respect and understanding.

In 2003, Tokushimakita High School was designated by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology as a Super English Language High School. Since then, Tokushimakita High School has been putting emphasis on English language education and international communication. We have sister school relationships with a total of three senior high schools in Germany, New Zealand and Thailand.

5 Educational Goals of Tokushimakita High School

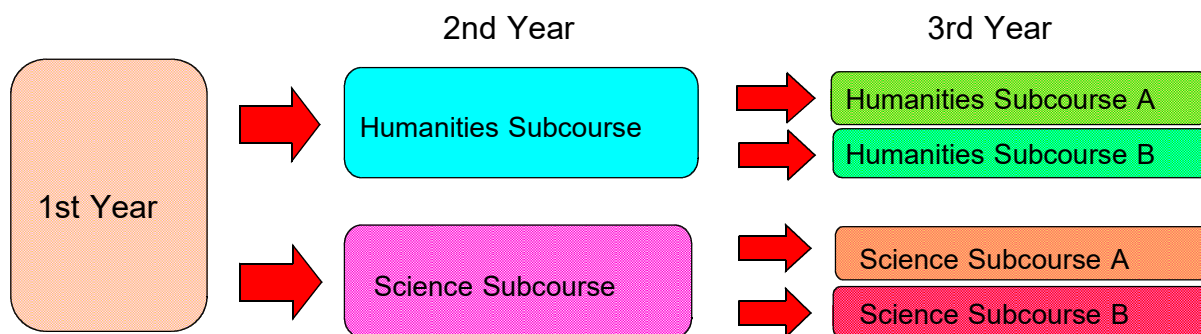
- (1) To foster individuals who can pursue truth and act independently and self-reliantly.

1 General Course

The General Course offers the curriculum which caters to each student's interest, future goal, aptitude and abilities. In the 1st year, students study the same subjects. In the 2nd and 3rd year, they can choose to enroll in either the Humanities Subcourse or Science Subcourse. Both subcourses offer a variety of elective subjects which help students to study actively so that they can improve their academic abilities in the area of study they are interested in.



Humanities Subcourse

General Course students can enroll in either the Humanities or Science Subcourse according to the future goal they have in mind. The Humanities Subcourse focuses on studying the Japanese language, Social Studies and English. In this course, students can improve their interests and abilities in the field of the humanities and social sciences. Students can gain wider perspectives and a flexible way of thinking. In the 3rd year, students can choose either the Humanities Subcourse A or B according to their future needs.

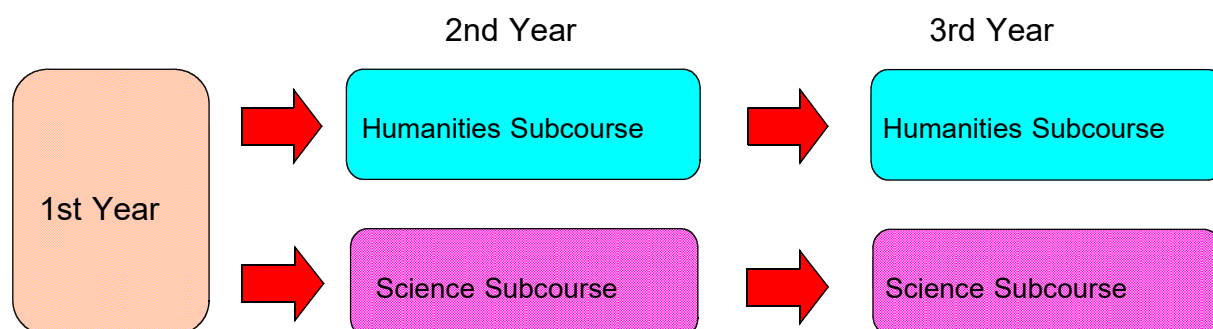
Food Design

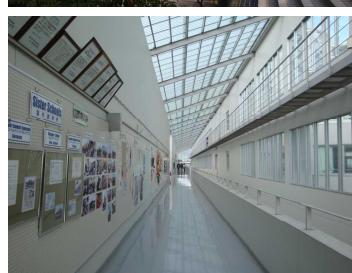

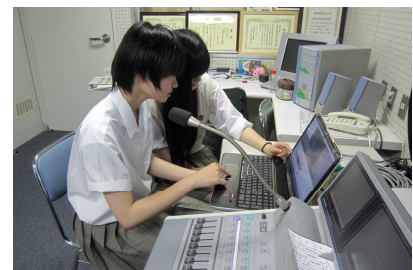
